Fairbanks Ranch Valve Replacement Project

To ensure that your current and future water needs are met, the Santa Fe Irrigation District has embarked on a water valve maintenance program in Fairbanks Ranch, replacing all of the valves. The project is part of our long-term mission to continually maintain and improve the water infrastructure for our customers.



Project Status

The Santa Fe Irrigation District has begun preliminary work on the Fairbanks Ranch Valve Replacement Project. You may have noticed construction crews working on the street near your home. The crews are examining the existing water valves that will be replaced, noting their size and configuration.

Replacing the Valves

We will begin to install the new water valves starting the first week of June. The valve replacements will last for approximately four to five months. To minimize the inconvenience to residents, the project area has been divided into 13 different sections and we will replace all the valves in one section per week. When the valves are replaced, it will be necessary to temporarily shut off the water to that section. We will make every effort to limit the water shut-off to one 12-hour period per section.

Valve Replacement Procedure

For each section, the actual valve replacement work will occur every Thursday. Residents will receive a mailed reminder at least one week prior to the Thursday valve replacement date. On the Tuesday prior to the Thursday valve replacement date, we will visit each home in-person and confirm that your water will be temporarily shut off or inform you that, due to unexpected delays, valve replacement for your section will be delayed by one week.

Water Shut-off Schedule

We are currently finalizing the water shut-off schedule. Once it is set, we will mail you a copy of the schedule, post the schedule on our website, www.sfidwater.org, and post the schedule at the main guard gate to Fairbanks Ranch.
