**Santa Fe Irrigation District Water Service Normal**

**Rancho Santa Fe, CA** – This update is provided by the Santa Fe Irrigation District (SFID) to provide current information regarding the status of District operations. The District office was closed for normal business this week due to the mandatory evacuation of Rancho Santa Fe. Normal business hours for the office will resume at 7:30 AM on Friday, October 26, 2007.

The District's R.E. Badger Water Filtration Plant and water distribution system remained fully operational throughout the wildfires this week. There were no disruptions of water service to the areas served by SFID. District staff manned the water filtration plant throughout the wildfire event to ensure water supplies for public health and safety. Initial assessments indicate there has been no major damage or problems with District facilities. Routine water quality sampling is ongoing and water supplies meet all Federal and State standards.

Due to the evacuation of the District Administration office and the threat of the wildfire to the filtration plant, the District activated its Emergency Operations Center (EOC) at approximately 9:00 AM on Monday, October 22, 2007. The EOC was established at the City of Encinitas City Hall. The EOC was deactivated at 11:00 AM on Thursday, October 25, 2007.

District crews are working throughout the District to continue damage assessment efforts and respond to customer service requests.
