## **BOARD APPROVES NEW DIVISIONS WITHIN THE SANTA FE IRRIGATION DISTRICT**

**RANCHO SANTA FE, Calif.**— At the January 19, 2012 Board of Director's meeting, the Board unanimously approved a redistricting map which adjusted the Santa Fe Irrigation District's (SFID) Division boundaries. SFID has five Divisions, and each Division is represented by an elected Board member.



At the Board of Director's meeting on October 20, 2011, the Board identified two alternatives to update the existing Division boundaries for redistricting. Two public meetings were held to allow public review and comment on the two alternative maps.

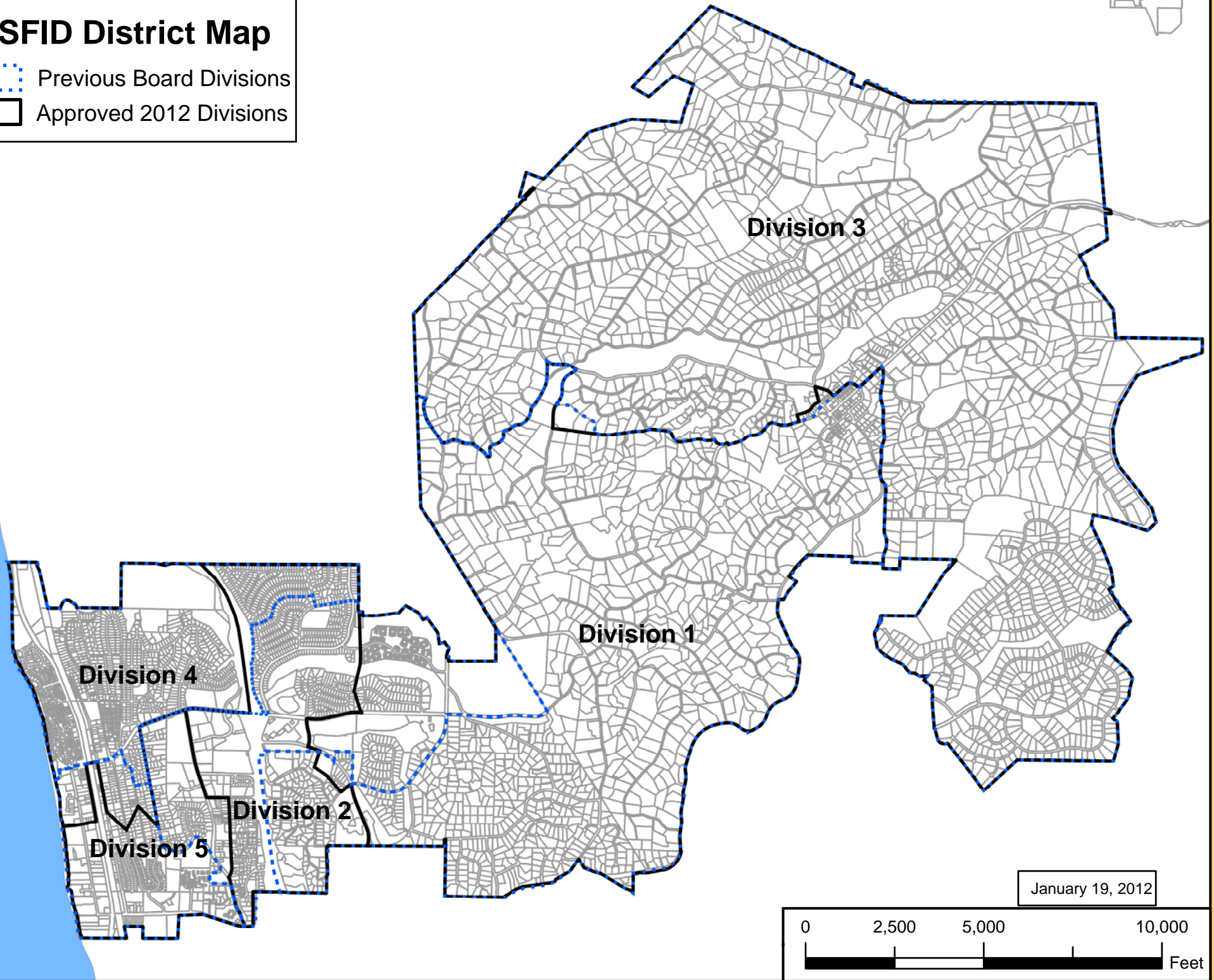
The Division boundaries were changed, as required by the California Elections Code, which require SFID to review and adjust (if necessary) all division boundaries following each decennial federal census. The Divisions are to be as nearly equal in population as may be possible.

The new Division boundaries will be in effect for the November 2012 elections, and the approved Division map is available on SFID's website at [www.sfidwater.org](http://www.sfidwater.org).

**About Santa Fe Irrigation District** The Santa Fe Irrigation District provides water and related services to residential, commercial and agricultural customers in the communities of Rancho Santa Fe, Solana Beach and Fairbanks Ranch. The District serves about 20,000 customers in a 16-square-mile area. The District supplies over 4.5 billion gallons (or 13,500 acre feet) of water per year to its customers, using a blend of local water from Lake Hodges and imported water purchased through the San Diego County Water Authority. The District operates the jointly owned R.E. Badger Filtration Plant, a 40-million-gallon-per-day water-treatment plant. The District owns rights to local water supplies from Lake Hodges and the San Dieguito Reservoir.
